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To authenticate a Freshbooks Cloud Accounting connector instance, you must register an app with Freshbooks. When you authenticate, use the **Client ID**, **Client Secret**, and **Redirect URI** as the **API Key**, **API Secret**, and **Callback URL**. You will also need to provide a Company Name.

If you've already set up an app and just need to know how to find your **Client ID**, **Client Secret**, and **Redirect URI**, see Locate Credentials for Authentication. If you need to register an app, see Create an Application.



To find your OAuth 2.0 credentials:

- 1. Log in to your account at Freshbooks.
- 2. Click the application that you want to connect.
- Record the Client ID. Client Secret, and Redirect URI.
