

Twilio SMS API Provider Setup

To create a connection to Twilio SMS, call the `POST /instances` API to instantiate your Twilio SMS connected app.

The Twilio SMS connector is a collection of resources providing a pre-built integration into a service endpoint. RESTful methods (POST, GET, PUT, PATCH, DELETE) are used to interact with these resources (accounts, contacts, files) regardless of the type of APIs (SOAP or REST) provided by the endpoint. Connectors leverage SAP Cloud Platform Open Connectors API Manager platform services including authentication, data transformation, and event management. The API is built to allow you to create a functional application or integration quickly and easily.

All API calls to SAP Cloud Platform Open Connectors should be made to the

`https://api.openconnectors.us2.ext.hana.ondemand.com/elements/api-v2`

base domain. Requests are authorized with an Organization and User secret, as well as, a connector token. We use many standard HTTP features, like HTTP verbs, which can be understood by many HTTP clients. JSON will be returned in all responses from the API, including errors. The APIs are designed to have predictable, straightforward URLs and to use HTTP response codes to indicate API errors.
