NetSuite - TaxCodes, TaxRates and TaxGroups

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NetSuite has a variety of endpoints related to tax information, and the following guide clarifies how SAP Cloud Platform Open Connectors maps the different tax endpoints.

/tax-codes

Our tax-codes API is mapped to NetSuite's TaxType endpoint. Here's a sample payload from our tax-codes endpoint:

```

/SalesTaxItem

Using the /{objectName} where objectName was SalesTaxItem, you will be able to retrieve data from NetSuite's TaxCode endpoint. Sample payload:

```
"internalId": "636",
    "itemId": "New York County",

    "rate": "1.50%",
    "includeChildren": true,
    "taxAgency": {
        "internalId": "1339",
        "name": "New York County"

    "taxAccount": {

}
```

Note that the "taxType" field is identical to the payload that you received from the CE

standardized GET /tax-codes.

/tax-rate

Finally, the /tax-rate endpoint is mapped to the taxGroup NetSuite resource, returning the following payload:

```
{ "itemId": "NY - Manhattan", "internalId": "638", "isDefault": false, "isI nactive": false, "includeChildren": true, "rate": 8.5, "nexusCountry": { "in ternalId": "US" } }
```

NetSuite Limitation

When using the tax codes (Sales Tax Items) endpoint, there is no association returned for Tax Groups and no way to force the return of that association.
