Connector instances represent a single authenticated user for any connector, such as DropBox, Google, or any other API provider that you wish to connect. To authenticate with a service, you will enter the credentials associated with your account, and every call you make through that connector instance will use your account for that connector. For each user or customer that is connecting to any connector, a different connector instance will need to be created.
