

How do I Create a Transformation with an Array?

When defining a common resource with an array, use the following format:

```
keyToArray[*].keyToValuesInArray
```

This will result in:

```
{ "keyToArray": [ "keyToValuesInArray": "1", "keyToValuesInArray": "2" ] }
```
