- 2. In the sidebar, click Advanced Settings, and then click Legacy API Settings.
- 3. Click the ellipses next to the account that you want to connect, and then click Edit.

- 4. Enter a **Username** and record it to use during authentication.
- 5. Record the API Token and API Path.
