

# Infusionsoft REST API Provider Setup

To authenticate a Infusionsoft REST connector instance you must register an app with Infusionsoft. When you authenticate, use the **client\_id**, **client\_secret**, and **Callback URL** as the **API Key** ( `oauth.api.key` ), **API Secret** ( `oauth.api.secret` ), and **Callback URL** ( `oauth.callback.url` ).

## Locate Credentials for Authentication

If you already created an application, follow the steps below **client\_id**, **client\_secret**, and **Callback URL**. If you have not created an app, see [Create an Application](#).

To find your OAuth 2.0 credentials:

1. Sign in to your [developer account](#).
2. Record the **client\_id** and **client\_secret**.
