To set up the API provider:

- 2. Go to: https://accounts.shopify.com/signup to become a Shopify Partner. It's free to sign up.
- 3. After you sign up, from the Dashboard > Apps, click Create App.



4. Fill out the App Information. In the **App URL** enter your application callback URL, and then click **Create App**.
