

NetSuite - How Can You Query by Custom Fields?

To search by custom fields in NetSuite, you'll first need to know what type it is. For example, to search on a custom boolean field you can send the `where` clause as

```
`custom.boolean.scriptId` = 'custentity_2663_direct_debit' and  
`custom.boolean.value` = 'false'
```

Please note you have to escape the `custom.boolean.scriptId` in back ticks.

To search a multi-select field value, use the following format:

```
`custom.multi.scriptId` = 'custentity1' and  
`custom.multi.value.internalId` = 1
```

To search for a long value, use the following format:

```
`custom.long.scriptId` = 'custentity1' and `custom.long.value` =  
1000
```

The following custom types are supported: `boolean`, `long`, `string`, `multiselect`,
and `enum`.
