To authenticate a Rally connector instance you must create an account with Rally and generate an API key.

- 1. On the login page, log in with your Rally (CA Agile Central) username and password.
- 2. Once you log into your account, you will see three tabs at the top of the page Authorized Applications, API Keys and OAuth Clients. Click API Keys.
