


# Rally API Provider Setup

To authenticate a Rally connector instance you must create an account with Rally and generate an API key.


1. On the [login page](#), log in with your Rally (CA Agile Central) username and password.
2. Once you log into your account, you will see three tabs at the top of the page - **Authorized Applications**, **API Keys** and **OAuth Clients**. Click **API Keys**.



3. You can find your existing API key under **My Keys**, as shown in the above image.

In case you do not already have a key, you need to create one.

1. Click on the **Create New API Key** link.



2. Enter a name or description for the key in the description field.

3. Select the read-only or full access option from the Grants section.
4. Select **Create**.
