If you are having trouble connecting to your database, check your config file to make sure the port and bind-address have been set.

Example Config:

/etc/mysql/my.cnf
port = 3306
bind-address = 127.0.0.1 localhost
#bind-address = 159.203.5.166 external

In this example, the <u>localhost bind-address</u> is not commented out so it will be used as the <u>db.host</u> value in the POST /instance configuration. The port is set to <u>3306</u>. In this case when you authenticate a connector instance, use <u>127.0.0.1:3306</u> as the value for <u>db.host</u>.

If you want to expose the external bind-address, then comment out the localhost bind-address.

If you want to expose both sources ( localhost and external ), then comment out both addresses.
